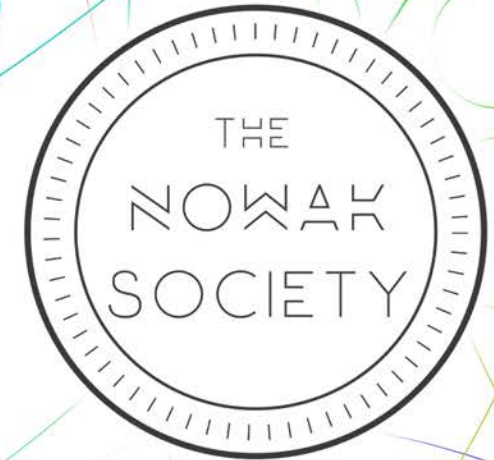

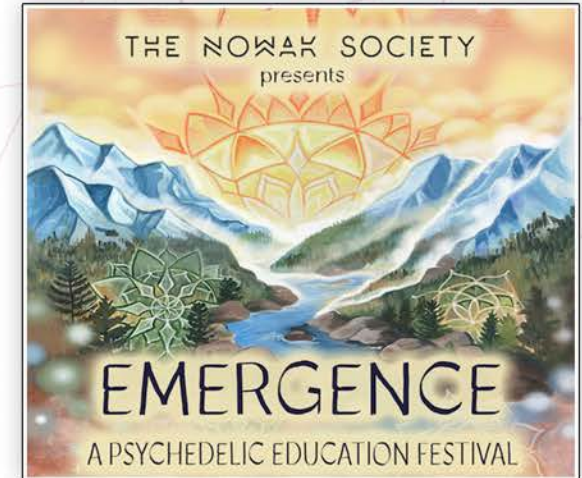
OUR INTENTIONS
